

At the October 4, 2017 Council Meeting, the Martinez City Council approved placing a new Veteran's Monument at the All Veterans' Park (corner of Alhambra Avenue and Berrellesa Street). The monument is a joint project of VFW Post 1351 and American Legion Post 29 to honor the Martinez men and women who served their country and died during time of war.
